Winter is here and we don't have a fireplace, but these drinks are pretty damn close. Our drinks change with the seasons, availability & the quality of the ingredients we can find (only the best will do!), so try these winter warming wonders before it's too late!

To make the best possible drinks, you need the finest ingredients available. We only use the freshest fruit we can find at the Queen Victoria Market. The egg white we use is from Organic Free Range eggs, our juices fresh pressed daily, we housemake our syrups & expertly infuse our spirits.

** Chilli, Chocolate Concubine

Woodford Reserve Bourbon, Crème de Cacao, Pear puree, shaken into a wine glass, and topped with a Candied Chilli Foam and Chocolate shavings

Rum Cha **

Appleton Estate Reserve Rum, Port, Apple Liqueur, Saffron and Vanilla Butter, Rum Soaked Raisins, Cloves, Cinnamon, Nutmeg, served in a Hot Mug, or a Tea Pot for Two (\$35).

Single Blossom

Housemade Rosemary syrup, Pesychaud's bitters and Marmalade slowly stirred over ice with a healthy dose of Wyborowa Vodka

Floating Snow

Zybrovka Vodka, Lemoncello Liqueur, Pesychaud's bitters, freshly pressed Lemon juice, shaken and strained over Calpico ice cubes and crowned with fresh pressed Apple juice.

Falling Cloud

Herradura Silver Tequila, Apricot Liqueur, and Patron Coffee Liqueur, shaken with Cracked Pepper and free range Egg White

White Tiger

Tanqueray Export Strength Gin, Apple Liqueur, Pear puree, Pistachio and Cardamon syrup, fresh pressed Lemon juice, and a dash of Pesychaud's bitters

*** Red Cheongsam

Bacardi 8yo Rum, Tanqueray Export Strength Gin, Shiraz, Licor 43, Cinnamon and Juniper syrup, loads of fresh Mint leaves, crushed ice & Soda water

Sleeping Dragon **

Hennessy V.S Cognac, Woodford Reserve Bourbon, Walnut syrup, Pesychaud's Bitters, served in a Fig Water atomized glass

Monkey's Magic – Yang - \$15, \$16**

Yang are lighter (not weaker) style cocktails, designed to refresh and revive.

The Alcohol used in these drinks "Sochu" is commonly known as "Japanese Vodka" (distilled Sake 'rice wine'). We chose this spirit for our infusions due to its neutrality and softness, taking on the optimal amount of flavor from whatever we choose to infuse in it.

Lychee & Lavender Martini

Lychee infused Sochu, Fresh muddled Lychees, Plymouth Gin, home made Lavender syrup & fresh pressed Lemon juice

Hot Passionfruit Fix

Chilli infused Sochu, Licor 43, Fresh Passionfruit pulp, fresh pressed Orange juice & housemade Pineapple syrup

Bloody Mary Monkey

Garlic infused Sochu, Tobasco, Horseradish, Worcestershire, Soy, fresh pressed Lemon juice, topped with Tomato juice

Chilli & Rose Royal **

Chilli infused Sochu, Absinthe soaked Sugar Cube & homemade Rose syrup, topped with Sparkling wine

Kaffir Lime Leaf cobbler

Kaffir Lime Leaf infused Sochu, Punt e Mes, fresh pressed Orange juice & housemade Vanilla syrup

Red Bean Milk Punch

Ginger infused Sochu, Stone's Ginger Wine, muddled Red Beans, Soy Milk & housemade Five Spice syrup

Fuji Apple & Jasmine Martini

Ginger infused Sochu, Fresh muddled Fuji Apple, Apple Liqueur, housemade Jasmine syrup & fresh pressed Lemon juice

Plum Plum Sour

Plum infused Sochu, muddled Plums, Frangelico, Vanilla syrup, fresh pressed Lemon juice & optional Egg White (for texture)

Daiquiri

Bacardi 8yr old Rum, fresh pressed Lime juice & Sugar syrup (*Monkey style is equal parts Lime & Sugar & double that of Rum*)

Margarita

Herradura Silver White Tequila, Cointreau Orange Liqueur & fresh pressed Lime juice (*Monkey style is equal parts Lime juice & Orange Liqueur & double that of Tequila, straight up or on the rocks, with a ½ salt rim*)

Manhattan **

Woodford Reserve Bourbon, Rosso Sweet Italian Vermouth & Angostura bitters (*Monkey style is how it should always be served! 3 parts chilled Bourbon to 1 part chilled Sweet Vermouth with a couple of dashes of Angostura bitters*)

** **Old Fashioned**

Woodford Reserve Bourbon, Angostura bitters & Sugar syrup (*Monkey style is fast & precise, a dash of sugar syrup, 3 of Angostura bitters & chilled Bourbon, over ice in a rocks glass. Perfect every time!*)

Mojito

Bacardi 8yr old Rum, fresh Mint leaves, fresh pressed Lime juice, Sugar syrup & Soda water (*Monkey style is 8 slightly bruised (Never broken!) Mint leaves, equal parts fresh Lime juice & Sugar syrup & lots of good Rum. Over crushed ice in a tall glass, with a charge of soda water*)

BUBBLES

Reputedly invented by the 17th century monk & Cellar Master of the Abbey of Hautuillers 'Dom Perignon' when he added yeast & sugar to a bottle of wine, which fermented & gave off carbon dioxide. Champagne can only be produced from 3 grape varieties (Chardonnay, Pinot Meneuir & Pinot Noir) grown in its namesake region in France. Whereas Sparkling Wine can be produced from any grape variety, grown anywhere in the world. New Zealand's Marlborough region creating an excellent example.

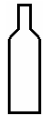

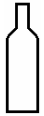

TEQUILA

Tequila, what the Gods drink when they want to have fun! A little more expensive than you might expect Tequila to be, especially when comparing their age's to the Rums above. It's because the 'Blue Agave' plant that it's produced from takes up to 12yrs to grow to harvesting maturity, whereas Rums 'sugar cane' takes only 12 months.
